

2020 DENIS COTTERELL ENDLESS SUMMER MEET

ENTRY PROCEDURE & EVENT DETAILS

Location

Centenary Aquatic Centre, 400 Gregory Terrace, Spring Hill

Eligibility

This meet has been designed to provide a quality hit out for swimmers who missed the QT for 2020 Australian Age Open Championships and are looking to finish the LC season with a great swim. Qualifying times apply.

The Meet is open to SQ registered swimmers, members of Clubs affiliated with other State Associations and international swimmers who meet clearance criteria.

Interstate & International Competitors Clearances

Clearances must be submitted to entries.qld@swimming.org.au before the nominations closing date. International swimmers/teams must supply a letter of clearance from their National Swimming Federation. International swimmers training with clubs in Australia must be nominated under their country name not the Australian club name.

Age

Age group of competitors for this meet is the age as at the first day of the Meet – 4th April 2020. Minimum age is 11 years.

International swimmers/ teams who do not have access to OME may request a Manual Entry Form by emailing dcendlesssummerclassic@rackleyswimteam.com.au Manual Entries must be received by 5pm, Monday 9th April 2020.

Late Entries

All entries submitted after this time will incur a late nomination fee of \$15.00 per event.

Late entries will be accepted in the timing room up until 1 hour before the commencement of each day of competition. Late entries are subject to lane availability in the event and may result in swimmers being entered in the slowest heat.

Refunds

No refunds will be given for withdrawal from the meet unless its due to medical reasons. If withdrawing for medical reason notification must be given via email and refund request with medical certificate provided within 7 days of meet.

Qualifying Times

Qualifying times must have been achieved at an approved qualifying meet (either short course or long course) on or after 1 January 2016. Entries with no times or NT will not be accepted. Converted short course qualifying times will only be used where an existing long course qualifying time has not been achieved. Swimmers who are attending Swimming Australia 2020 Age/Open championships cannot compete at this event. If a swimmer has achieved a national qualifying time and is not attending Age/Open Nationals - subject to availability they may enter events - please note in this case whilst times will be official, they will compete in a similar way to visitors and not displace medalists/placings or club points for other swimmers. Rules

All Swimming Queensland General Rules, Championship By-Laws, SAL & FINA Swim Rules apply.

Warm up/down Pool

Warm up for the night session will be in main pool before racing commences and in dive pool (20mtr) during events. During Day time Heats sessions, the Dive pool will be available for warm up/down from 11.30am on Saturday and 10.30 am Sunday.

Events & Medals

All events except 800/200mtr will be conducted as Heats and Finals (Top 10).

Heats will be swum on a "seed-entry" basis, not in age groups i.e. competitors will be grouped by time rather than by age group. Finals will be swum in age groups for the Top 10.

Medals will be awarded for the following Age Groups: 11y, 12y, 13y, 14y, 15y, 16y & over. Age Champions will be awarded to the top points scoring Male and Female in following Age Groups 11y, 12y, 13y, 14y, 15y, 16y & over.

Prizes

Cash Prizes for the Top 3 Point scoring Clubs. 1st Prize \$500, 2nd \$300 3rd \$200.

Entry Fees and Tickets

Swimmers and Coaches: No Entry Fee

Spectators: Session Entry fee \$5.00, 2 day event pass \$8.00.

Coaches

Coaches will receive a printed program and Food and Beverage throughout the meet.

Photos

In nominating for this Meet, swimmers agree that they may be photographed by Rackley Swim Team approved photographers, that the images may be displayed for viewing on site during the Meet and Rackley Swim team website after the Meet, and that they may also be used by Rackley Swim Team and/or Swimming Queensland at its discretion.

Centenary Aquatic and Fitness Centre has plenty of grandstand seating with shade cover.
