This meet is designed as an end of year hit-out for younger swimmers and older swimmers who are not competing at the 2020 Queensland Championships.

Time	1pm (warm up available from 12:15pm)
Nominations	All event nominations can be made through Swim Central. The entry process is only available to financial Swimming Australia competitive members.
Eligibility	Entry is open to all SQ registered competitive swimmers.
Age	As at 28th November 2020.
Nominations Close	Midnight Thursday 19th November 2020 - subject to a cap restriction with a 4 hour timeline.
Event Fees	\$7 per individual event plus GST. A 2.5% system fee, and a 1.5% transaction fee will be applied in the shopping trolley.
Multiclass	MC swimmers welcome and will be seeded according to Age and Time.
Events	This meet is sanctioned by Swimming Queensland and times will be recognised as official qualifying times for the Brisbane and Queensland Championships. All events will be swum as timed finals. The technical manager, in consultation with the referee, reserves the right to combine heats on the day. Swimmers aged 11 years and over are eligible for Open events. Each swimmer can swim a maximum of 5 individual events.
Refunds	No refunds will be given for withdrawal from the meet unless it is due to medical reasons. If withdrawing for medical reason, please notify us as soon as practical and email your refund request with medical certificate provided within 7 days of meet (bank fees will be deducted).
COVID safe meet information	In order to comply with Queensland Government regulations for the running of COVID Safe events all nominees must confirm they agree to the below: Meet Information for Attendees SQ COVID -19 Terms and Conditions As per Swimming Queensland's COVID-19 Club Activity/Meet Guidelines this Meet will be run as a CLOSED MEET which means NO SPECTATORS. A pre-allocation to Clubs based on athlete numbers will allow for adult attendance. These adults (parents/carers) would fill the role of Club/Team Manager to help supervise and support the athletes from their Club during the event. Coaches will be provided with one free program per club available for collection on the day from the Officials desk. Entrants will be capped to comply with COVID rules based on the estimated timeline being no longer than 4 hours.

- Awards** Medals will be awarded to the three fastest swimmers in the following age groups:
- 50/100m Events: 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15 and years & over
 - Open Events: three fastest place getters only.
- Timekeeping** A time keeping roster will be emailed to Race Secretaries and posted on our website closer to the meet date. All Clubs competing are required to provide timekeepers during the meet based on the number of nominated swimmers.
- Facility** The Hibiscus centre has a limited amount of shade and seating areas. Please bring your own chairs and shade cover.
- Food** The kiosk at the Hibiscus Centre will be open for purchase of coffee, soft drinks and other goodies.
- Events** 12:15pm warm up – 1pm start
